International Fire Academy (IFA) prepared course for Czech firefighters from Fire Rescue Brigade of Moravian-Silesian Region (FRB MSR) to enhance and improve skills for fires and other type of interventions in road and rail tunnels. Course was divided into two days theoretical part and two days practical part, both parts were realized in two runs per 30 persons. Theoretical part was arranged in Ostrava during 26.-27.2.2019 and 28.2.-1.3.2019, where IFA instructor Mr. Markus Vogt made 60 participants from FRB MSR familiar with the special conditions of deployment at great penetration depths, instructed them in the most important theoretical fundamentals using case studies and introduced the tactics and techniques required for deployment in road and rail tunnels. Practical training was held during 1.-2.7.2019 and 5.-6.7.2019 Depending on the requirements of FRB MSR the individual training sections were carried out at our Lungern and Balsthal sites, where firefighters could practice tactics and techniques under realistic conditions.

Complete program represented a tailor-made combination of all the training elements of the International Fire Academy for road and rail tunnel interventions use.

On behalf of my colleagues, I want to appreciate all 60 firefighters and FRB MSR representatives for smooth cooperation and for their disciplined effort and hard work in our training facilities.

The training project with the FRB MSR was a great success. Since the practical training on the basis of staff and long travel time, costs and effective possibility had to be kept rather short, the theoretical training on site was absolutely compelling, but also profitable. Thus, the training package can be considered as a good entry into the tunnel incident management.
